In the five presidential elections since 2000, Democrats have won the popular vote in all of them, but yet lost the election in two of them. One due to the Supreme Court stopping the vote counting in Florida and the second due to the Electoral College, a remnant of slavery that allowed states to count people as three fifths of a whole person.
